There is a **Loop system** in the Church compatible with digital hearing aids.

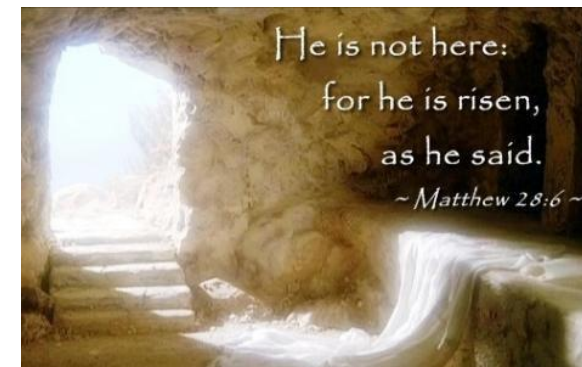
